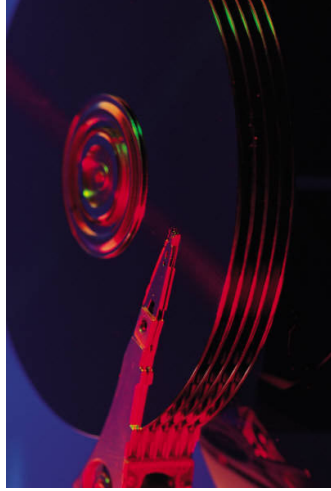


### A Sample of First Year Activities/Topics

Learn the normal operation of PC operating systems and various computer applications, build a PC from its component assemblies, install a variety of network operating systems, repair or replace problematic computer parts, correct mis-configured software and troubleshoot network problems with system utilities.

Install WIN2003 server, Implement WSUS server, setup multiple web-sites within IIS, manage domain users and use RIS to upgrade clients.

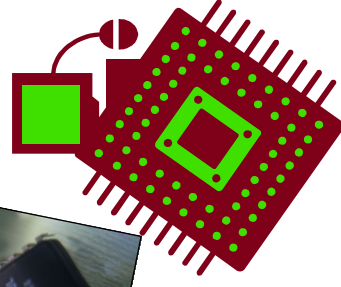
